ASC Grants Prompt Artistic Exploration for Faculty, Staff, Alumni

Quick Facts

- Two faculty/staff members received grants: Shaun Cassidy and Chris O'Neill '98, '10.
- Two alumni received grants: Holly Glasscock '86 and Betsy Birkner '97.

ROCK HILL, SOUTH CAROLINA — Several Winthrop University faculty, staff and alumni will explore their artistic interests further thanks to [Arts & Science Council of Charlotte](#) grants.

Each year, the council, along with fellow councils in six North Carolina counties and York County, the North Carolina Arts Council and **Blumenthal Endowment**, awards project grants to artists throughout the region.

This year, four in the Winthrop community received grants:

- **Chris O'Neill '98, '10**: \$1,907 to purchase a MacBook Pro for multimedia creation and integrated show control. O'Neill is the facilities management/technical director for the [Department of Music](#) and head of Shakespeare Carolina.
- **Professor of Fine Arts Shaun Cassidy**: \$2,000 to purchase sheets of metal to create a new sculpture series.
- **Holly Glasscock '86**: \$800 to attend the 2015 Plein Air Convention and Expo. The expo offers instruction, painting demonstrations, mentorship and more with international artists.
- **Betsy Birkner '97**: \$2,000 to purchase a laptop. Birkner is an artist-in-residence at the McColl Center for Art + Innovation.
