

The papers of Mary Johnston (Pat) Gates, former president of the South Carolina Extension Homemakers' Council and civic leader, were received as a gift by the Archives from Mrs. Gates on July 21, 1977.

Notices were released to NUMC on October 3, 1977 and the University of Minnesota Women's History Survey on August 11, 1977.

Scope and Content Note: The Mary Johnston Gates Papers consist of correspondence, minutes, histories, financial records, program notes, newspaper clippings, photographs, scrapbooks, and reference material, relating to the South Carolina Extension Homemakers' Council (1930-1976), Bethel Home Demonstration Club (1941-1975), the National Extension Homemakers' Council (1948-1976), the Associated Country Women of the World (1968-1976) and the South Carolina Agricultural County Extension Work (1928-1968). There is also a 16mm film describing the dedication ceremonies of the Bethel Home Demonstration Club of Sumter, South Carolina, the first of its kind in the United States. Correspondents include Strom Thurmond, senator from South Carolina; Donald Russell, former South Carolina governor and United States senator; Olin D. Johnston, former South Carolina governor and United States senator; Corinne B. Riley, representative of South Carolina; and Anna H. Huntington, sculptress (see Box 12-Folder 36). Related records would include other collections in the Archives pertaining to home economics, home extension, and home demonstration in South Carolina, especially Acc. 71, the South Carolina Extension Homemakers' Council records, and Acc. 103, Mrs. W.G. Cochran Papers.

Disposition of Items: A 1954 U.S. Department of Commerce *Census of Agriculture* was transferred to Documents Department, Dacus Library. All duplicates have been returned to the donor.
