
If you recall the 1975 session of the legislature authorized preliminary planning money for this project and the 1976 session authorized final planning money.

I am concerned that if the legislature became aware that so much time has elapsed without progress they may be inclined to red line the entire project.

I also wish to point out that in another month or so Mr. James Bibb will be so wrapped up in legislative budget meetings that it becomes extremely difficult to schedule him in any Architectural Selection meetings.
