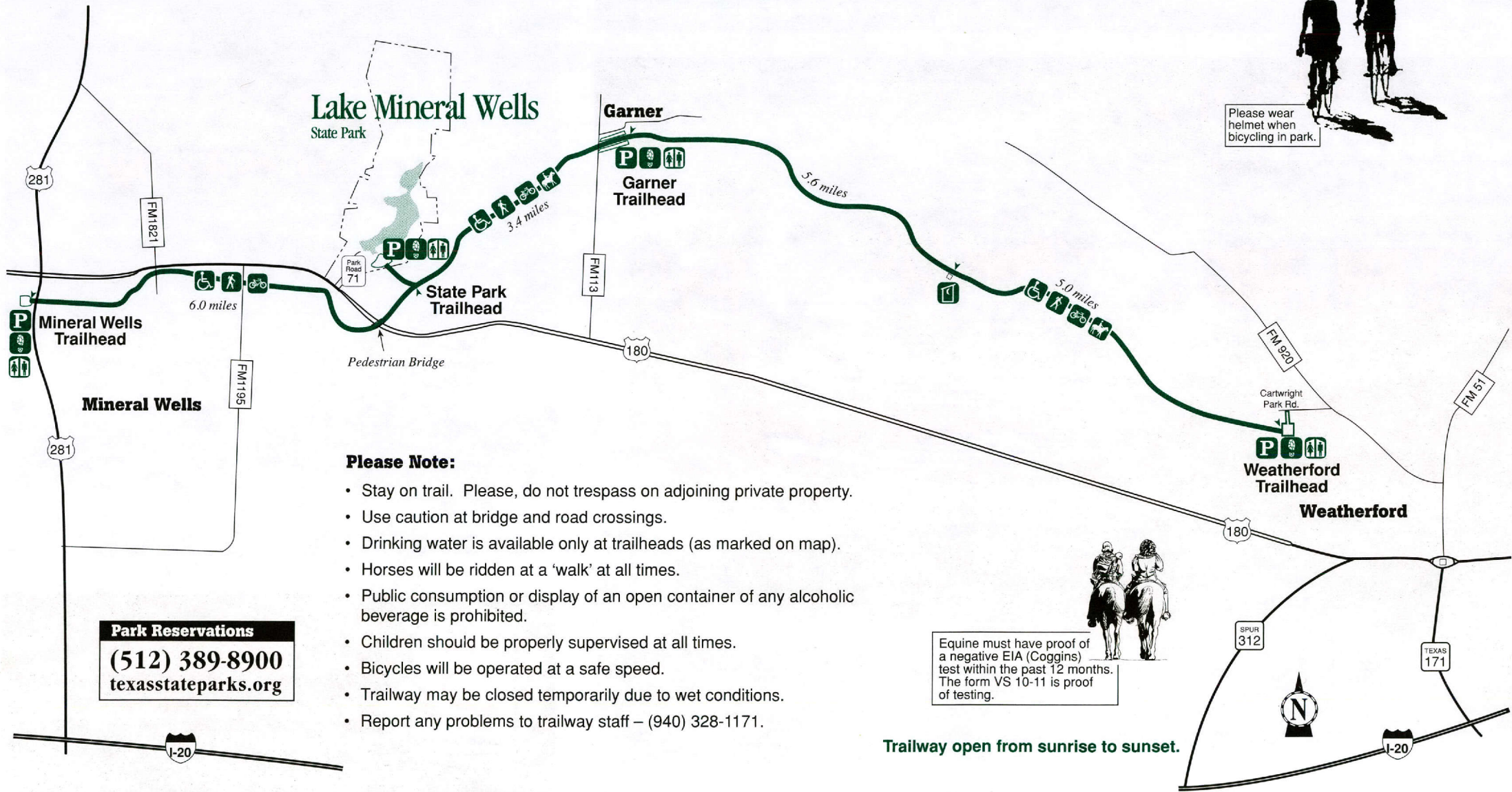


# Lake Mineral Wells State Trailway

Trailway open from sunrise to sunset.

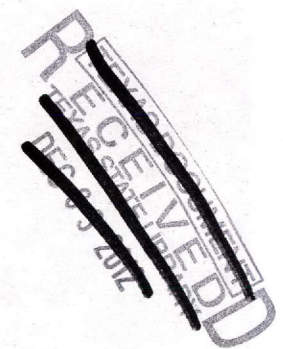
## Legend:

- Children should be properly supervised at all times.
- Bicycles will be operated at a safe speed.
- Trailway may be closed temporarily due to wet conditions.
