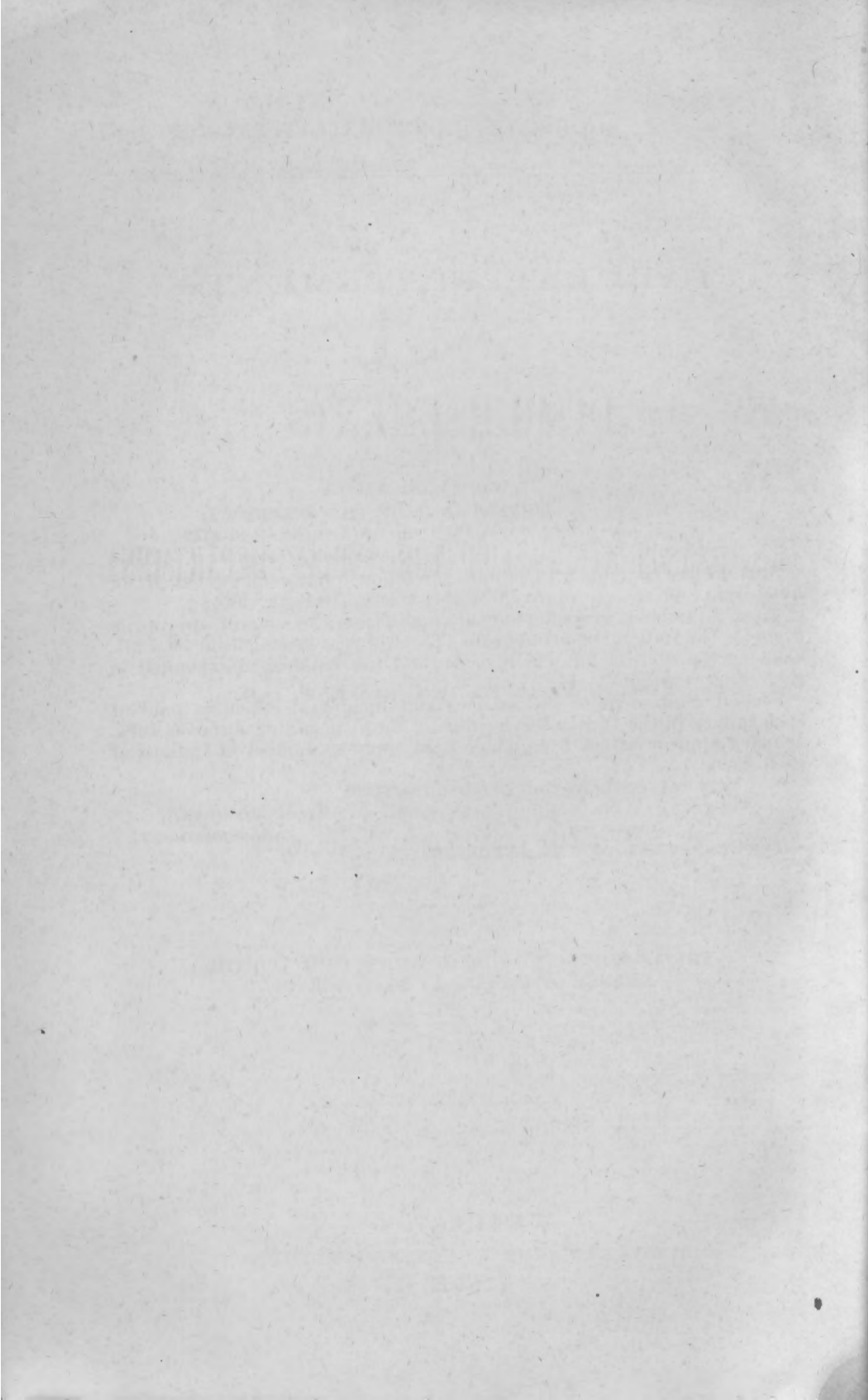
THE APPROPRIATIONS FROM WHICH PAID AND THE
