## REPORT.

That the memorialist alleges in this petition that, on the 31st of August, A. D. 1855, a body of hostile Indians from the republic of Mexico invaded the State of Texas, and murdered a negro girl by the name of Lucy, belonging to him.

As there is nothing in the shape of evidence to sustain the allegations of the memorialist, the committee ask to be discharged from the

further consideration of the memorial.
