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
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Plans and Pivots: Embracing Change in an IR Marketing and Outreach Program

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Plan: Liaison librarians ask faculty to become Scholar Commons users Problem: Most liaison librarians did not use Scholar Commons

Pivot: Submission drive among liaison librarians before beginning faculty outreach



FEBRUARY 2017

Plan: Present to Arts &
Sciences Council of Chairs
to get buy-in from multiple
dept chairs


Problem: Only one dept chair (History) joined after the presentation

Pivot: Decided to focus on getting new History faculty users in SC

Outcome: 3 new History faculty users (13% to 31% for the department)

PROJECT SUMMARY

During the 2016-2017 academic year, SCU Library launched a pilot marketing and outreach program to increase faculty users of Scholar Commons, the Institutional Repository.



SEPTEMBER 2016

Plan: Use a faculty
 champion's enthusiasm
 to get more users at a

 meeting

Problem: Meeting invitation was rescinded due to packed agenda

Pivot: Invited the faculty champion to be honored at the SC Soiree (for all faculty)

Outcome: 17 faculty from various depts. joined the IR

Key Takeaway:Re persistent!

Outcome:

5 new Psych faculty (from 33% to 60% participation for the department)

PROJECT TAKEAWAYS

Tailor outreach; enthusiastic Chair is key; student work as a way in for faculty involvement; leverage student labor via academic departments; small gains add up; be open & ready to pivot!

OCTOBER 2016

Plan: None. Pivot: None. Description:
Chair of Women's & Gender Studies asked
Liaison to help create a multidisciplinary
Gender & Sexuality Studies themed
collection in Scholar Commons.

Outcome: 10 faculty users from multiple departments joined Scholar Commons through this initiative so far.
