

A LumberJack Sunflower, Blooming from Undergraduate Research

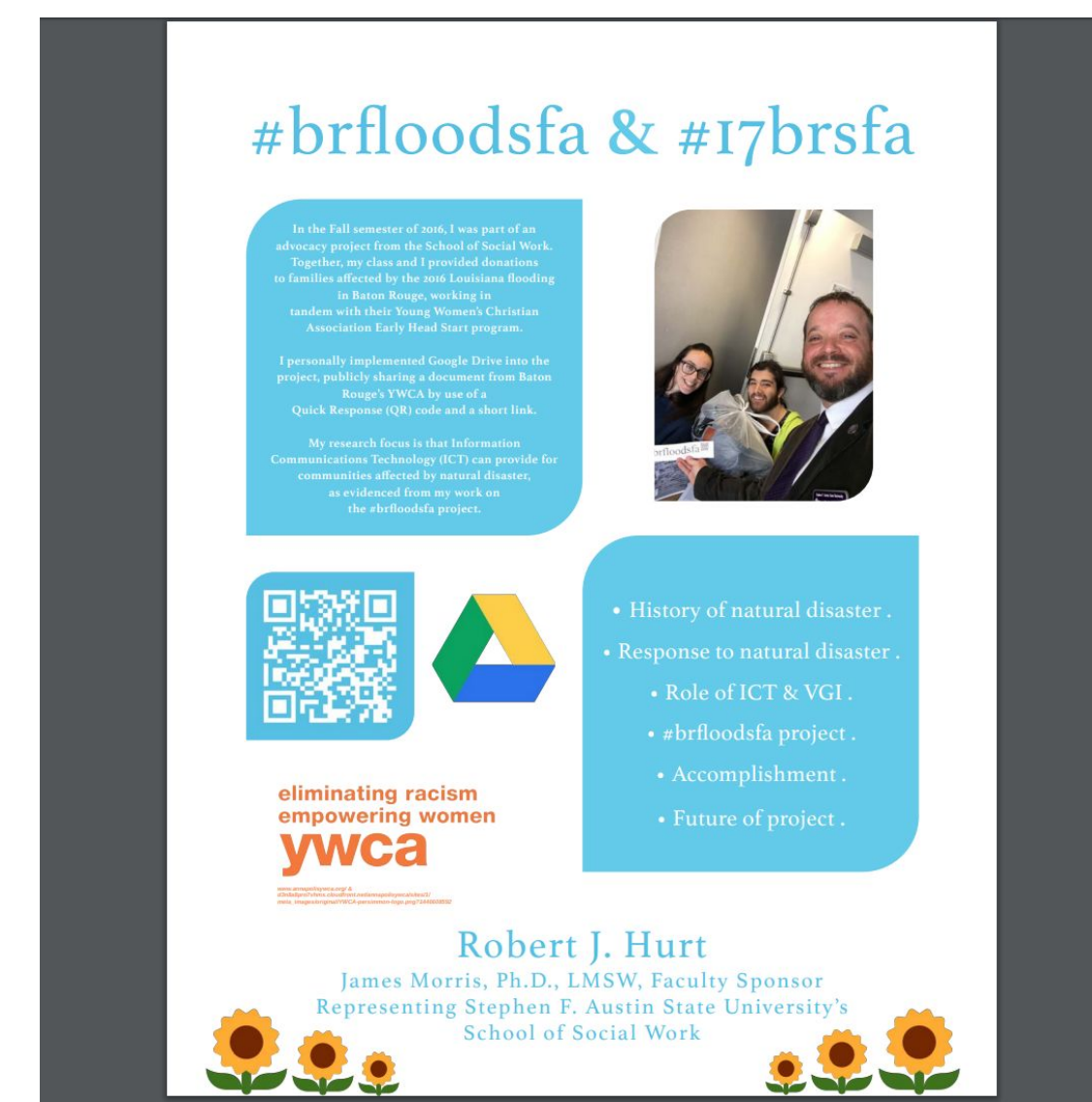
