

DURHAM, N.H. -- The University of New Hampshire University Advising and Career Center (UACC), in conjunction with the Whittemore School of Business and Economics, and the College of Engineering and Physical Sciences, invites employers from across the state and region to participate in the 2004 UNH Career and Internship Fair.
