Three Key Points



- 1. Catholic schools are seeking to improve their special education programs.
- 2. Teachers at faith-based schools (e.g. Catholic schools) lack training in special education and less use of related services.
- 3. There are five prominent special needs diagnoses in Marin County.

Method



- Qualitative study that explores the current state of a Resource Program at a Catholic K-8 school
- ✓ Voluntary, anonymous survey of teachers, administrators, and support staff✓ Ten survey questions
- Observation of current program
 Using a classroom checklist

Findings



- Total participants = 20 members of the faculty
- 60% possess a graduate level degree Only 4 teachers have special education certification
- 46.67% indicated 'somewhat prepared'
- Desire for trainings, workshops, professional developments, and more resources

Conclusions



- Administrators hire well-qualified, trained teachers in special education
- Opportunities for professional development
