noun.

- A recounting of a sequence of events
- A narrative, either true or fictitious designed to interest, amuse, or instruct the hearer or reader

identity

noun.

• the sense of self, providing sameness and continuity in personality over time and sometimes disturbed in mental illnesses

ritual

noun.

- Standardized behavior with a beginning and an end
- Mark the passage of time or passage from one state to another
- Define and reinforce beliefs of the participants or define and reinforce community.
