A ton of hay will consist of two thousand pounds; or, by measurement, three hundred and forty-three cubic feet, after the same shall have been stacked thirty days, or such time as may be agreed upon between the parties.

A perch of mason work or stone is hereby declared to consist of twenty-five feet, cubic measure.

TREATING FLAX FOR WILT.

The method of seed treatment recommended is essentially as follows:

Good, bright, plump seed is selected and cleaned with a fanning mill until only heavy weight seed remains, blowing out all bits of straw, chaff, dust and scaly seeds.

Treat the seed with formaldehyde, using standard formaldehyde at the rate of sixteen ounces avordupois to forty gallons of water. Use a spray pump which will throw a forceful, misty spray. After the seed is all cleaned in the fanning mill, throw it down on a tight floor or canvas and rake or shovel it over while it is being sprayed with the solution. Rake, spray and shovel slowly until you have put on at least one-half gallon of solution for each dry bushel of seed flax. Pile the flax up in a pile, cover with a canvas and it will be right to sow in approximately two hours. Treat in the morning that which you wish to sow in the afternoon. Treat in the afternoon what you expect to use in the morning.

Caution:—WHILE THE FLAX SEED IS BEING SPRAYED BE SURE TO STIR IT THOROUGHLY AND, IF IT HAPPENS THAT YOU CANNOT SEED IT, THEN IT MUST BE SPREAD OUT TO PREVENT HEATING.

MEASURING HAY IN THE STACK.

The formula worked out by the Department of Agriculture to ascertain the number of cubic feet in a stack of hay is as follows:

" $0.225 (O - W) OW + H$. O is the distance over the stack; W is the width; L the length, and H the height. First, subtract the width from the distance over; then multiply by the distance over; this by the width, and this product by the length, and this whole product by the fraction 0.225, and divide the result by the height of the stack. All the measurements must be in feet and the fractions of a foot. Working out the problem in this way gives the total number of cubic feet in the stack."

The number of cubic feet required to weigh a ton varies with the length of time the hay has settled, the kind of hay, with the amount of moisture it contains, with the weather, etc.

The number of cubic feet required for a ton of hay in North and South Dakota is 343, while the Montana statutes require 512 cubic feet for a ton of timothy or alfalfa.

However, this is probably too much for alfalfa, and the usual measurement accepted in that state is 422.

The size of cube required to weigh a ton is a matter of agreement between the contracting parties.

GOVERNMENT WHITEWASH FORMULA.

Take a half bushel of unslacked lime, slack it with boiling water, cover during the process to keep in steam, strain the liquid through a fine sieve or strainer, and add to it a peck of salt, previously dissolved in warm water, three pounds of ground rice boiled to a thin paste and stirred in while hot; half a pound Spanish whiting and one pound of glue, previously dissolved by soaking in cold water, and then hanging over the fire in a small pot hung in a larger one filled with water; add five gallons of hot water to the mixture, stir well and let it stand a few days covered from dirt. It should be applied hot, for which purpose it can be kept in a portable furnace.

SOAP WASH FOR PLANT LICE.

For plant lice dissolve one pound of whale oil soap in 6 to 10 gallons of water and apply with rag or spray pump.

DRY CURE FOR MEAT.

To 1,000 pounds of meat take the following:

Forty pounds of common salt, 10 pounds of New Orleans sugar, 4 pounds of black pepper, 1½ pounds of saltpetre and ½ pound of cayenne pepper.

Let the meat cool thoroughly. Mix ingredients well and rub one-half of the mixture well into the meat. Place meat in a cool, dry place—never in a cellar.

After two weeks rub the remainder of the mixture into the meat and let it remain six weeks. It is then ready for smoking, which should be done slowly.

POTATO BUGS.

Spray plants with Paris green, one pound in 50 gallons of water, with two pounds of quicklime added. Best used with Bordeaux mixture to prevent blight and destroy bugs with one operation.

CRESOL SOAP FOR CHICKEN MITES.

Shave or chop one ten-cent cake of laundry soap into one pint of soft water. Heat or allow to stand until a soap paste is formed. Stir in one pound of commercial cresol and heat or allow to stand until soap paste is dissolved. Stir in one gallon of kerosene. For use, dilute with 50 parts of water, which will make a milky colored liquid. Spray buildings thoroughly with this mixture.

Commercial cresol is a coal tar by-product and may be obtained from the druggist at about 30 cents per pound. Care should be taken not to get any of it upon the hands or face, as it will cause intense smarting.
