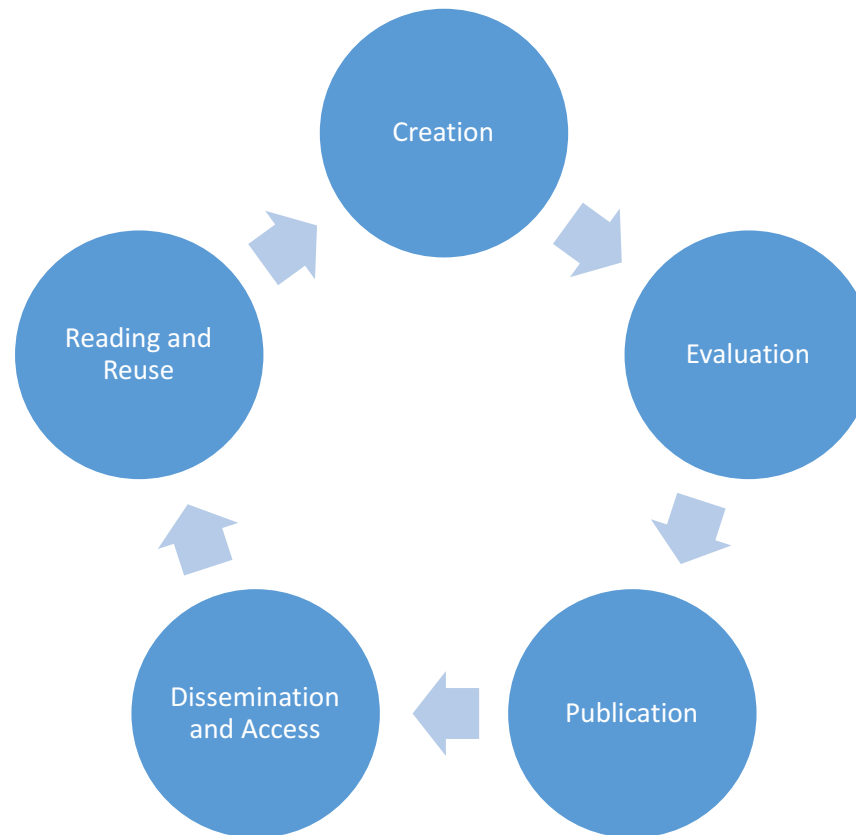

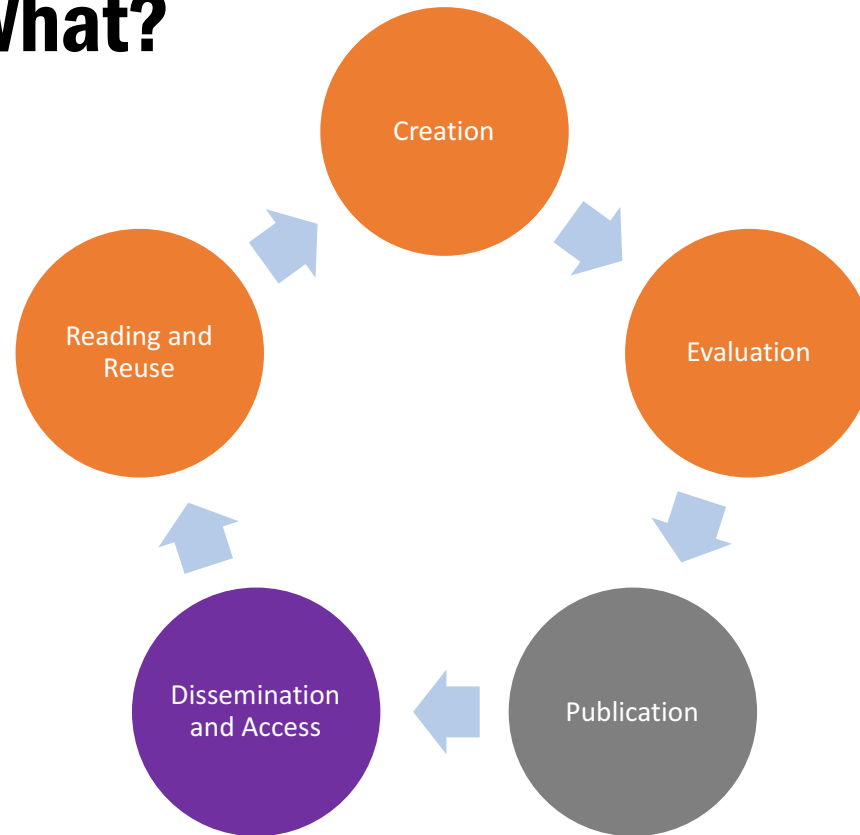

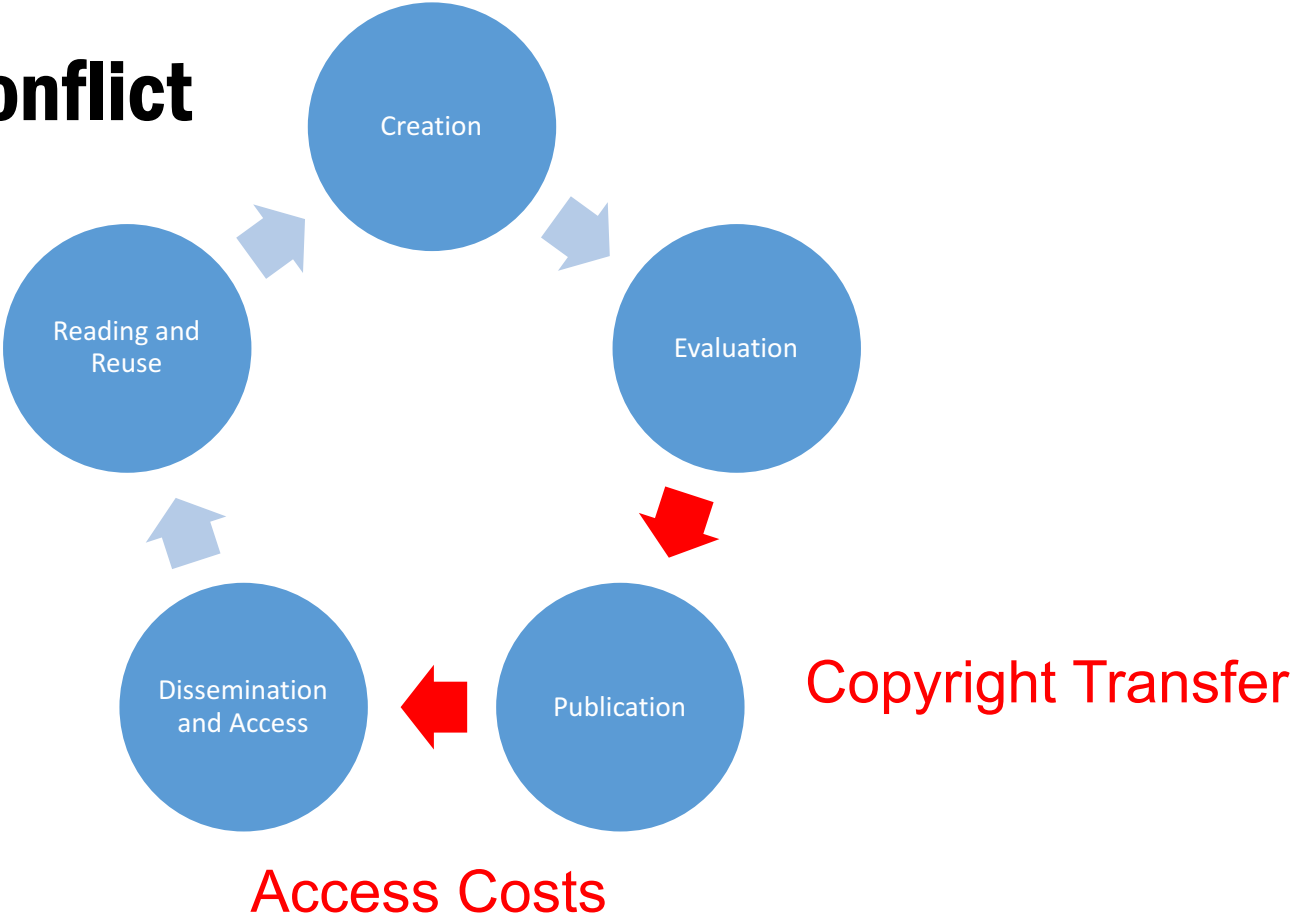
Traditional Lifecycle of Scholarly Information



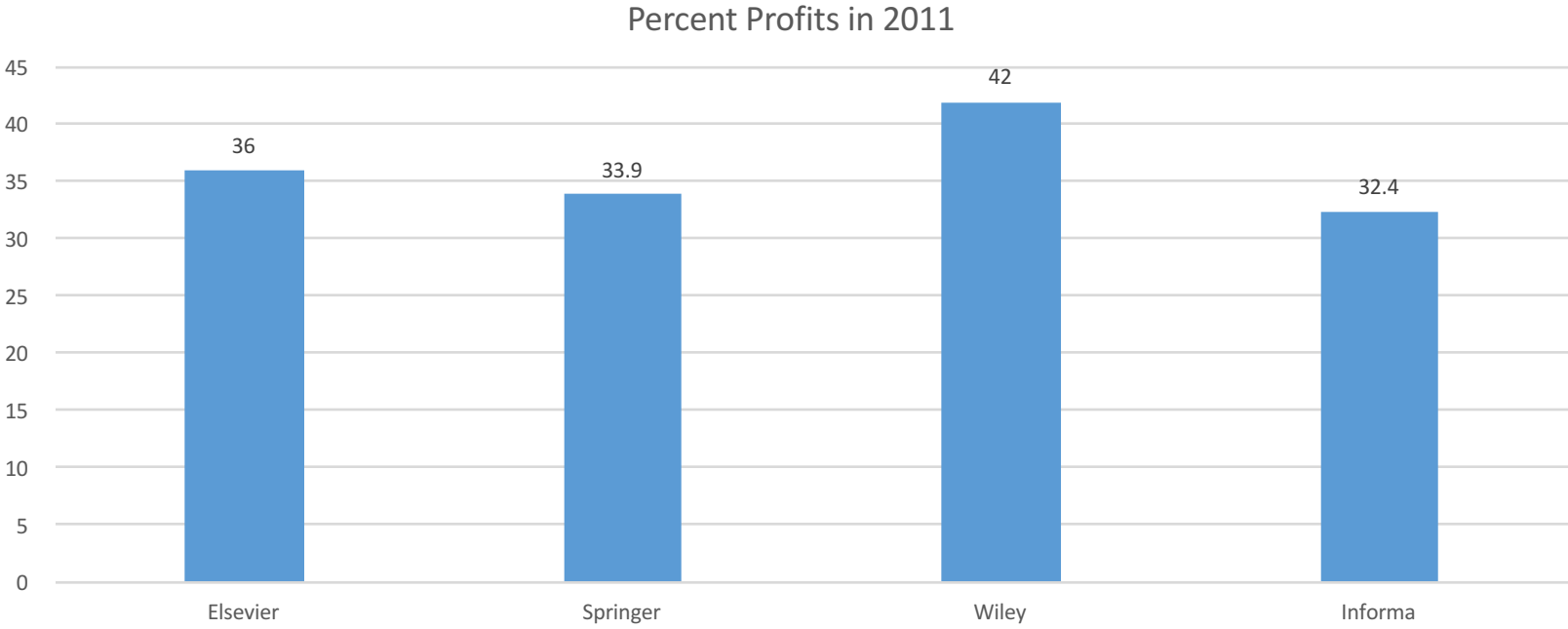
Who Does What?



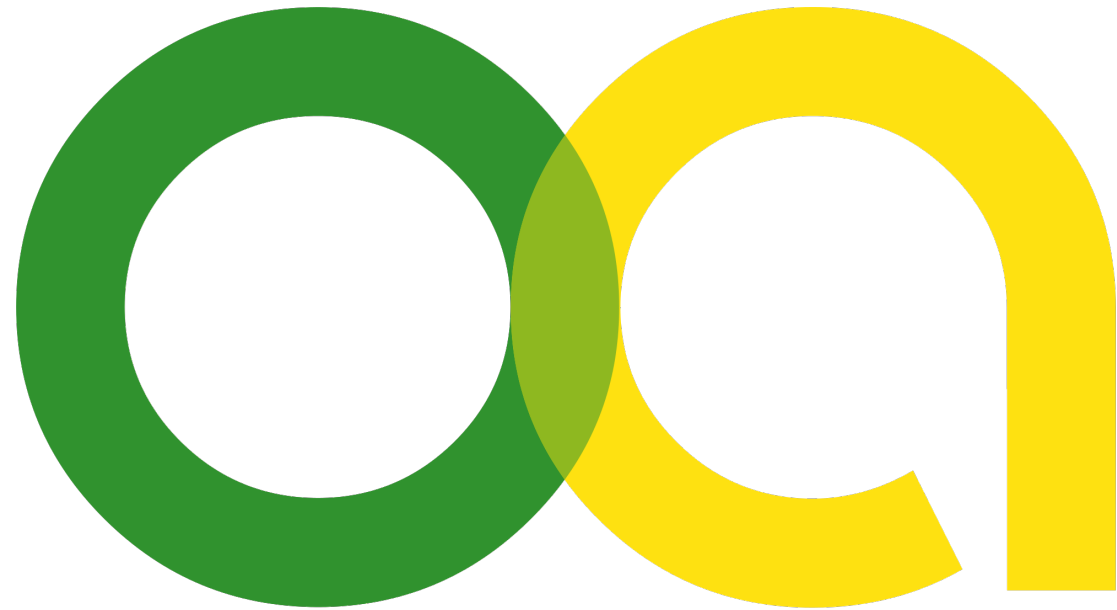
Points of Conflict

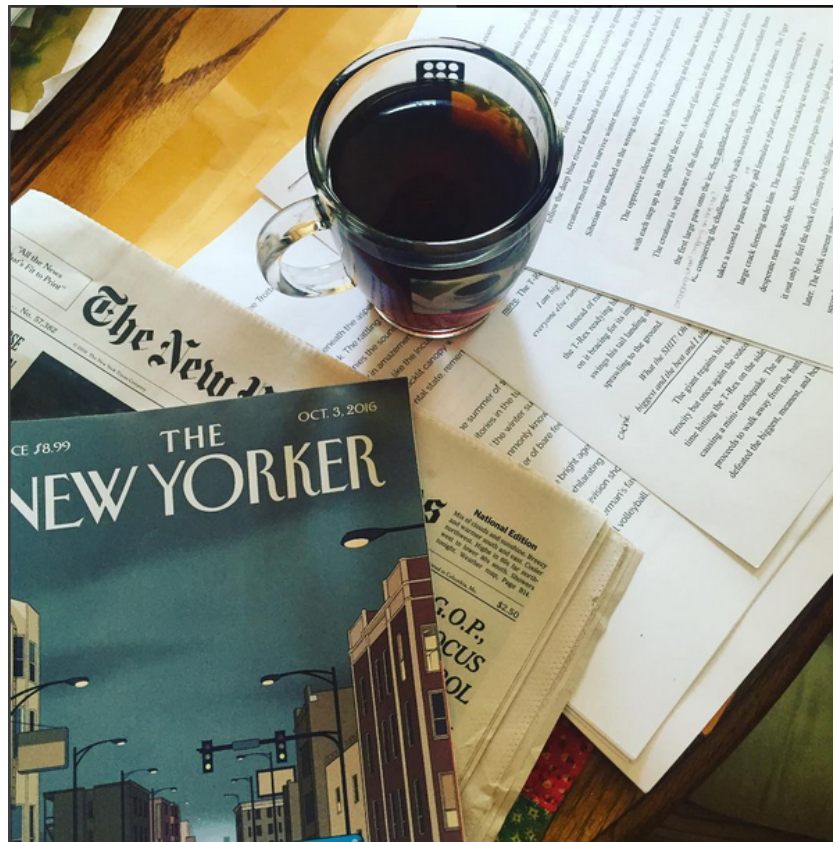

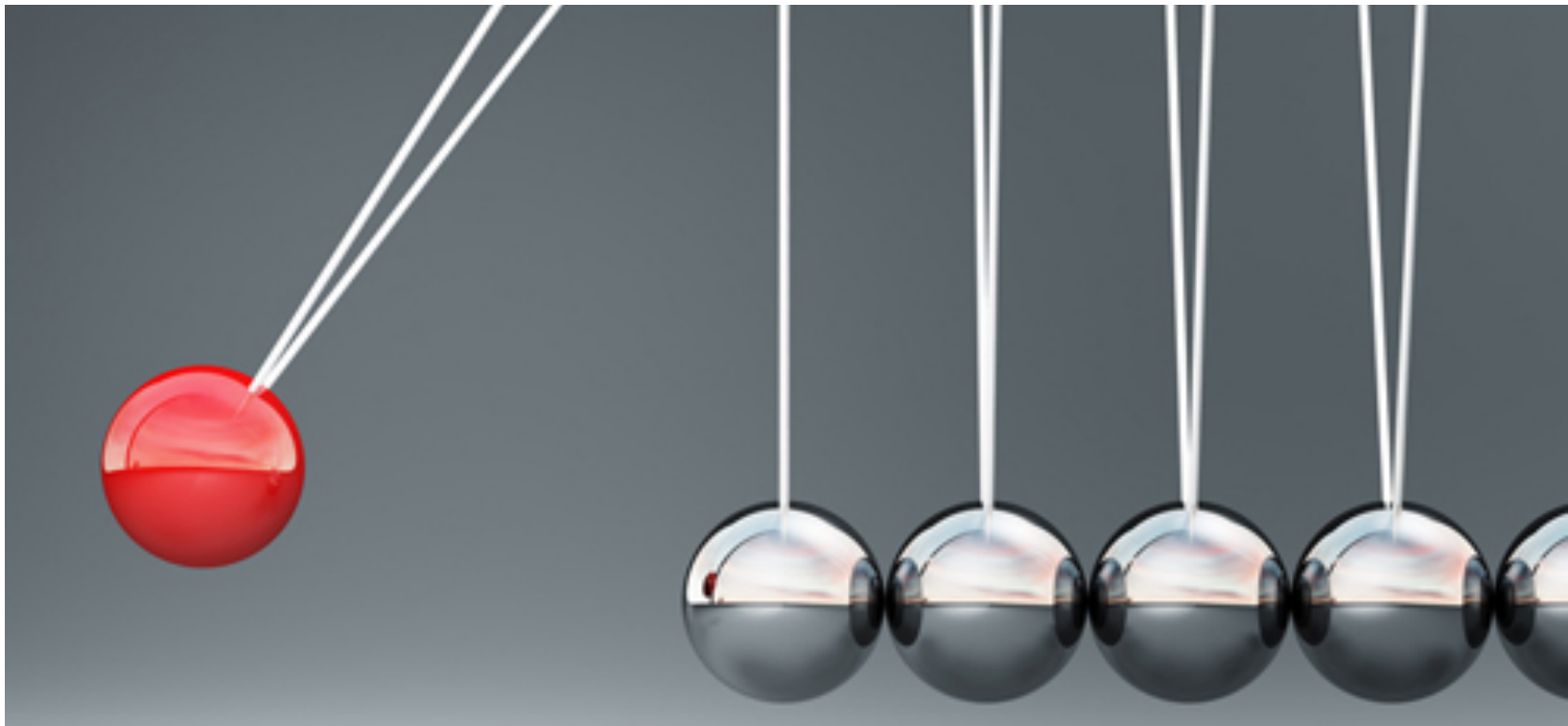
