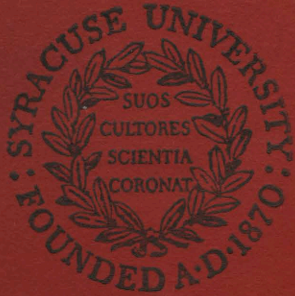

INTRODUCTION

Those familiar with the first two guides to Eastern African microfilm published by the Program of Eastern African Studies, Syracuse University, will observe a departure in the format of the present series, Microfilms Relating to Eastern Africa. The difference stems from the types of documents indexed and the manner in which they were filmed. The earlier guides - - R.G. Gregory, R. M. Maxon and L. P. Spencer, Guide to the Kenya National Archives (1969) and Harvey Soff, A Guide to the Coast Province Microfilm Collection (1971) - - are indices of microfilmed reports and correspondence of the administration of the British protectorate of Kenya, housed in the Kenya National Archives, Nairobi. Filmed by the Archives' technical staff, these documents appear in ordered groupings, and reels are numbered consecutively. This enabled the compilers of the two, earlier guides to use uniform index entries.

In contrast, documents indexed in the present series, Microfilms Relating to Eastern Africa, originated almost entirely from non-archival sources. With one exception, they were filmed by the Syracuse University Microfilm Project in co-operation with the Kenya National Archives.* Included are a number of newspapers, books, journals, published governmental reports, and correspondence and reports of various social, economic, agricultural and religious organizations. Being varied, these documents require differing forms of indices which are difficult to adapt to the uniform index

of the earlier guides. Furthermore, adoption of the old format, which indexes documents as they appear on consecutively-numbered reels, is confounded by the irregular numeration of reels. Up to September, 1970 the Syracuse Project gave to the reels derived from one group of documents (e.g., the complete run of a newspaper) its own set of numbers. It was found necessary to arrange these films in alphabetical order according to the title of the document filmed (these are grouped below under "Old Series").

If a useful understanding is desired of the organization of this and future guides in the series, Microfilms Relating to Eastern Africa, the section "The Use of the Guide" on pages v-x below is strongly recommended.

We hope that by the Spring of 1972, the next guide in this series Microfilms Relating to Eastern Africa, Part II will appear. Scheduled for indexing are the Kenya Weekly News, further records and correspondence of the East African Yearly Meeting of Friends (Kaimosi), the H. K. Binn diaries, Journal of the Royal Society of South Africa, Journal of the East African Swahili Committee, Revue de Madagascar, and others. Also in the Spring of 1972, work will have begun on the index to the 78 reels of the papers of various East African Asian organizations, which include 36 reels of correspondence and records of the East African Indian National Congress.

For their valuable assistance in the compilation of this Guide, thanks are due to Professor Robert G. Gregory, Supervisor of the Syracuse University Microfilm and Indexing Project, and Dr. Patrick J. McGowan, Chairman of the Publication Committee of the Program of Eastern African Studies, Syracuse University. (Mrs.) Judy Galligan, who for a regrettably brief time worked

as the guide's composer and typist, deserves special praise. The help of (Mrs.) Molly Ostwald, who patiently and cheerfully dealt with constant requests for microfilm and favors from her desk in the Library Processing Center, was deeply appreciated. Finally, the largest measure of gratitude is owed to the National Science Foundation and the Program of Eastern African Studies, Syracuse University, whose generous financial support made the undertaking of this guide possible.

A. "Old Series" and "New Series"

This guide is divided into two parts - - "Old Series" and "New Series." Films indexed under Old Series were filmed prior to September 1970 and are presently only to be found at the Syracuse University Main Library (for information on how to obtain films indexed in this guide, see Part C in this section). Indices to the Old Series reels appear on pages 1-62. Reels are arranged alphabetically, according to the title of the document on film. An index of document titles of the Old Series and New Series appears on pages 85-88. A number of Old Series reels await indexing and will appear in future guides in this series.

"New Series" films date from September 1970 in their production and are located at the Co-Operative Africana Microform Project, Chicago, Illinois (CAMP) and the Syracuse University Main Library. The New Series differs markedly from the Old Series in the way documents were arranged for filming. Documents in the New Series appear in irregular order, and a single reel may contain two or more distinct and unrelated kinds of documents. In the New Series section (pages 64-79) documents are indexed under the number of the reel in which they appear. An index of document titles appears on pages 85-88. The New Series reels indexed in this guide were

arbitrarily cut off at #44, leaving reels #45 and higher to be indexed in future guides. When requesting reels of the New Series through inter-library loan, bear in mind that procedure is different than in the case of Old Series (see Part C., in this section).

B. Index Entries

In order to insure their maximum utility, index entries have been assigned two primary functions: First, they are to indicate precisely what documents appear on a given film. The listing of missing documents, a temptation particularly great in the case of newspapers, has been avoided. Second, index entries are to correspond as closely as possible to the internal organization of the documents. Because of the variety of kinds of documents in this guide, there have emerged several basic categories for which a particular type of index entry is suited: newspapers; books pamphlets and papers; journals; organizational records, papers, correspondence, etc.; published governmental reports; unpublished governmental reports and registries; and municipal government committee minutes.

Newspapers. Index entries for newspapers consist of the volume and/or number of the issue and date of publication. When consecutive issues appear on film (i.e., when dates of publication or volume and/or numbers continue in regular fashion) the inclusive dates and volume/numbers are listed in one entry. N.B.: Index entries for newspapers do not represent newspapers filmed as a group. Runs of all newspapers were filmed without interruption. For example, the first five entries for the weekly, The Leader of British East Africa, on page 53, are listed:

Entries A through E represent issues of The Leader which, on the film, appear without interruption. For example, the last page of issue Vol. I, No. 13 (August 15, 1908) will appear immediately adjacent and before page 1 of Vol. II, No. 14 (August 22, 1908).

Reel 1 begins with thirteen consecutive weekly issues listed under Entry A. The inclusive dates of publication and volume and issue numbers are given. With the change in volume number, Entry B begins. Entry B consists of two consecutive issues. The next entry, C, occurs because of the duplication of numbers on two issues which have different dates of publication. Entry D begins at No. 17 because No. 16 has not appeared on the previous issue, even though no interruption in the weekly dates of publication has occurred. Entry E begins with No. 22 because neither No. 21 nor the previous weekly date appears on the film.

Books, Pamphlets and Papers: Index entries for books, pamphlets and papers consist of author, title, date and place of publication (excluded in some papers), and page length. Each item is indexed as it appears on the film.

Journals. Index entries consist of volume and sub-volume numbers, date of publication, and page length. Volumes are indexed as they appear on the film, and users should be aware that volumes can be in jumbled order. For example, Vol. III of Beitrage zur Kolonial Politik und Kolonial Wirtschaft (pp. 6-7) appears not between Vols. II and IV on Reel 1, but at the beginning of Reel 3, before Vol. VIII.

Organizational Records, Papers, Correspondence, etc. Index entries in this category correspond to the organization adopted by the filmers of the documents. On pp. 72-73, where the papers of the Indian Association, Nakuru are indexed, each entry corresponds to documents which have been filmed as a group (in this case, files of correspondence). Single entries consist of the title of the file, the inclusive dates (in years) of the contents and page length. In the case of the Selected Papers of the East African Yearly Meeting of Friends (Kaimosi) pp. 10-11, a number of published volumes appear. These have been indexed in the same manner as books, pamphlets and papers.

Published Governmental Reports. Index entries consist of the title of the report, date and place of publication, and page length. Because governmental reports are often issued annually, abbreviated titles have been made for annual entries subsequent to the first full entry. For example, on pp. 65-68, the annual reports of the Department of Agriculture (Nairobi) are listed in abbreviated form (e.g., Annual Report . . . 1926, 221 pp.) after the initial full citation. Note also that the abbreviated title is used alongside an abbreviated title taken from a different kind of report, in this case, Agricultural Censuses.

Unpublished volumes of governmental reports and registries. Index entries consist of Volume and Part numbers, title and sub-title (where present), inclusive dates of reports or entries contained in the Part or Volume, and page length.

Municipal Government Committee Minutes. This category applies only to the documents of the municipal Council, Nakuru, indexed on pp. 72 and 73-74. Owing to the great number of these brief documents on a given reel, there are no index entries as such, but rather a list of names of committees whose minutes and reports appear on the films. Page length is given only for the minutes as a whole, and date references are confined to the inclusive years of minutes on a given reel.

C. Requesting Film Through Interlibrary Loan

Films indexed in this guide and housed at the Syracuse University Main Library are not available through Interlibrary Loan. All requests should be directed to Co-operative Africana Microfilm Project, (or, C.A.M.P), Center for Research Libraries, 5721 Cottage Grove Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60637. Also available at C.A.M.P. are all films issued with "New Series" numbers. C.A.M.P. intends to acquire a set of "Old Series" films in the near future.

When requesting films in the Old Series (indexed on pp. 1-62), be certain to give the full title heading and the desired number of the reel(s) listed under the title heading. For example, if one wished to see Duckham, A.N., Report on a Visit to Kenya and Uganda in September/October, 1948, listed on page 8, the proper request would be made in this form:

Books and Pamphlets on East Africa. Reel 1.

When requesting films in the New Series (indexed on pp. 64-79) one need only give the New Series reel number. Thus, if one desired Boedecker, Dr. F., "The Early History of Nairobi Township," listed on page 74, the proper request would be made in this form:

New Series Reel #30.

N.B.: For New Series Reels, Numbers 1, 2, 6, 7, or 8, requests must be accompanied by the form, "Request for Access to the Kenya National Archives Microfilm Collection"(see Part D in this section).

D. Restrictions on Access to Microfilms and the Use of Microfilmed Documents in Published Form.

Restrictions on publication vary according to film and document and will be explained on cards appearing on the reels. Access to films of non-published documents from the Kenya National Archives, whether deposited at C.A.M.P. or at the Syracuse University Main Library, is restricted to those who have submitted the completed form, "Request for Access to the Kenya National Archives Microfilm Collection." A sample form, for xeroxing purposes only, appears on page 84. Of the films indexed in this guide, the request form need only be submitted for New Series Reels, Numbers 1, 2, 6, 7, and 8.

E. Syracuse University Main Library Microfilm Numbers

For those in Syracuse who are using the films indexed in this guide, a list of microfilm numbers used exclusively in the Syracuse University Main Library is provided on pp. 80-82. DO NOT use the Syracuse Library Numbers when requesting reels from C.A.M.P. through Interlibrary Loan. At Syracuse, microfilm numbers are catalogued in the Main Card Catalogue, Ground Floor, and in the Microfilm index in the Reference Room Card Catalogue, Room 210.

DAILY CHRONICLE

An English-Gujerati daily, the Daily Chronicle was founded in 1946 by Pio Gama Pinto who identified himself with the African nationalist cause in Kenya. The issues under Pinto's editorship were not available for filming. Pinto handed over the paper in 1952 to M. M. Bhatt who managed the paper until it folded in 1959. Issues filmed are those of Mr. Bhatt's collection. The Daily Chronicle customarily appeared daily from Tuesday through Sunday and each issue received its own "volume" number. This is not a complete collection, but a list of published issues was unavailable to determine which issues are missing. One ought not to infer that a missing "volume" number or missing day in this collection means a missing issue; observable irregularities of "volume" numbers and publishing dates argues against this. The following list includes only the issues in the filmed collection. Inclusive dates indicate consecutive issues, and do not correspond to any groupings on the film itself.
