#### Dear Father

We arrived here last Evening and were paid off as soon as we got here – at this rate we have been coming we wont get to Nashville for several days. Yet we run around over the country hunting Gurillas and all it amounts to is about half the men and Horses completely worn out -

I was takin sick Thursday night when we stopped for Camp Dr Lewis gave me some Medicine but next morning I had a high fever and had to go and ride in the Ambulance all day (Friday) at night I went into a Hotel and stayed all night and this morning I felt much better I wanted to go on with the

Brigade but Dr Lewis would not let me but got transportation for me by rail Road and I am going on to night at 11 P.M.
