


#### ACCESSIBLE FOR ANYONE


- Designed for library staff, but viewable on any browser with no login required.




#### WHY IT IS NEEDED

- Collection development is centrally managed, with input from subject liaison librarians.
  - Liaisons directly request purchased materials 99% of requests honored.
  - Liaisons may request subscription resources
     decisions made by collection development team.


#### HOW IT IS USED

- Collection development meets annually with subject liaisons to...
  - Request feedback from librarians on the direction of the programs and the collections.
  - Describe their collection and what their students and faculty use and/or need.




#### **COLLECTION MAP**






