SUMMARY:

A letter from one former employer recommends him in all respects, but shows they were forced to discharge him for knocking down another employee on company property. Letter from Baltimore & Ohio Railroad, Cincinnati, Ohio, shows subject worked for them as a yard helper from June 6, 1944 until October 31, 1951, recommends him in all respects and would re-employ him. Letter from Sheriff of Loudon County shows subject was a good prisoner while in jail, but knows nothing further about him because his home is in Ohio. Fairly close custodial care is recommended. Prognosis when released poor.
