
Dear John:

In any event, all best wishes to you and to the Candidate. You look good on television and handle yourself well. Perhaps you should run for some office.

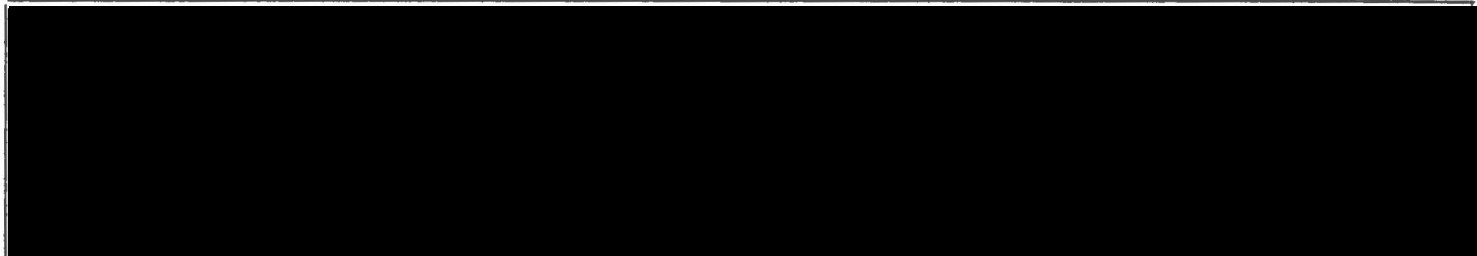
