WHAT: The John F. Sonnett Memorial Lecture Series at Fordham University School of Law will feature the Honorable Liam Hamilton, Chief Justice, Supreme Court of Ireland. The lecture, entitled "The Right to Life and Death," is free and open to the public.

WHO: The Honorable Liam Hamilton has had a distinguished career as a practicing attorney and jurist in Ireland for 40 years. He is currently the Chief Justice of the five-member Supreme Court of Ireland, which determines the constitutionality of statutes.
