REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

To the citizens of the town of Van Buren:—

I have the honor to herewith submit for your consideration the annual report of the condition and progress of the public schools of the town of Van Buren. Owing to the industrial depression existing for the past year our attendance has fallen off some; last year we had 1648 pupils in the elementary and secondary schools, at the present time there are 1452 registered in same courses, but with the mills reopening again I feel that our attendance for the coming year will be materially increased.

You will observe there are 46 teachers employed giving an average of 31 pupils per teacher which compares favorably with the conditions throughout the entire State. At nearly all of the schools the teachers have formed school improvement leagues, in this manner they are able by entertainments, card parties, etc. to purchase many things for their respective classrooms. With these funds they are enabled in many of the buildings to serve hot cocoa at noon lunch to those children who are obliged to come a considerable distance, some days there being as many as forty seated at the various tables partaking of their lunch in an orderly manner, always under the supervision of one or more teachers.

It is particularly interesting to note the number of students attending high school and to find that all portions of the town are represented, also to note the number of boys and girls who are pursuing higher courses in the various normal schools and colleges of the country..

Owing to the disastrous fire which completely destroyed the Convent School, so-called, in 1924, necessitating a program of two sessions at the St. John and Champlain Schools in order to care for the children made school less, the teachers and children worked under considerable difficulties but owing to the wonderful co-operation of parents and pupils and the zealous endeavor on the part of the teachers to cover their allotted program in so short a period, we find that the children have graded satisfactorily. Last September through the untiring efforts of the Rev. Fr. Ducks and the generous response given by the citizens of the Town, County and State, the beautiful new Sacred Heart School was made possible and today 488 children are receiving instruction therein.

I have no doubt that as the work of the elementary schools

becomes more fully worked out, under the greatly improved conditions which now exist that pupils will go into High School much better prepared and stronger work will consequently follow.

Before schools reopen in the fall, there are many repairs to be made, and all the buildings must be cleaned. Repairs should be made on the roof of the St. John School, also the plaster should be repaired and given a coat of muresco. At the Keegan school a furnace will have to be replaced. The rural schools are all in need of repairs.

Attention is called to the various reports and figures incorporated in that part of the Town Report devoted to school matters.

Again I urge the parents and all others interested in the schools of Van Buren to visit them often, in this way you will gain some idea of the type of work being carried on and we may profit by any suggestions which you might care to offer.

In conclusion I ask the voters of Van Buren to "Hold the Ground Gained". In closing this, my annual report, I wish to express my appreciation of the courteous treatment I have received from the Board of Selectment, and from the School Committee, and the hearty response of all teachers.

WARRANT

To Edgar Carboneau, a constable of the town of Van Buren, in the County of Aroostock and State of Maine

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said town of Van Buren qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Gayety Theatre, socalled, in said town of Van Buren, on Wednesday, the thirty-first day of March A. D. 1926, at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following articles, viz:—

1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
2. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year.
3. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for General Government as follows: Selectment, Assessors, Overseers of the Poor, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Collector of Taxes and Departmental Expenses.
4. To see if the Town will vote to elect or instruct the Selectmen to appoint a Road Commissioner in accordance with Section 16, Chapter 92 of the Public Laws of 1919.
5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Highways, Sidewalks and Bridges, as follows: Maintenance and equipment, roads and bridges, sidewalks, road commissioner, winter roads and patrol maintenance.

6. To see if the Town will vote "Yes" or "No" on the question of appropriating and raising money necessary to entitle the Town to State Aid, as provided by section 19 of Chapter 25 of Revised Statutes of 1916..

7. To see if the Town will appropriate the sum of \$1,194.00 for the improvement of the section of the State Aid Road as outlined in the report of the State Highway Commission, in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of the ways, highways and bridges; the above amount being the maximum which the town is allowed to raise under the provision of Section 18 of Chapter 25 of the Devised Statutes of 1916.

8. To see what sum of money, if any, the Town will vote to expend on the Parent Settlement Road.

9. To see if the Town will vote to raise money for the purpose of extending sewer drains along the streets of the town, and if so, how much, and also to determine the location where the same shall be built.

10. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise to extend the Deschaine Road to the Grand Isle town line.

11. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise to be expended on the Castonguay Settlement Road.

12. To see if the town will vote to grant and raise the sum of \$900.00 to pay the American Gas Accumulator Co., of Elizabeth, N. J. for three traffic beacons installed by them on our streets last fall, subject to the approval and acceptance by the town at this equalr town meeting.

13. To see what sum of money, if any the town will vote to grant and raise to pay for Calcum Chloride to be applied to the Village Streets.

14. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise the lower that part of Main Street and part of Hammond Street opposite F. O. Michaud's residence lot, to install drain or drains across said Hammond Street and also to lower watermains to a depth corresponding to the amount of surface removed.

15. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Health and Sanitation, as follows: Board of Health, Tuberculosis prevention, Vital Statistics and Health Officer.

16. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Charity and Mother's Aid as follows: Support of Poor, Mothers' State Aid and Dependent Children.

17. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the Protection of Persons and Property, as follows:—Police Department, Fire Department and Firemen, Hydrant Rental, Fire Inspector and Street Lights.

18. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the payment of Insurance premiums—Workmen's Compensation.

19. To see if the town will vote to install additional street lights and hydrants and, if so, how many, and also to determine the location of same.

20. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Education, as follows:—Superintendent of Schools, Superintending School Committee, Truant Officers, Common School Teachers Wages, Common School Tuition and Board, Common School Conveyance, Common School Fuel, Common School Janitors, Common School Supplies, Common School Text Books, High school Teachers' Wages, High school conveyances, High School Supplies and Text Books and Interest on School Fund.

21. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Common School Repairs, Insurance and Interest.

22. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Superintending School Committee to place one or more rural school in good condition, and if so, what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise for such purpose.

23. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the selectmen and Treasurer to issue and negotiate town of Van Buren notes for a sum not greater than \$100,000.00 to be paid out of money raised by taxation during the current year.

24. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the payment of interest and also for contingent expenses.

25. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise to create a Sinking Fund for the purpose of paying off bond indebtedness.

26. To see if the town will vote to accept the Town Officers' report.

27. To see if the Town will vote to fix a time when taxes shall be due and payable; and will vote to make any discount upon taxes paid at such time or times as it may determine; and if so, what per cent. also to fix a time and rate of interest to be added on taxes remaining unpaid.

28. To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise to take care of abatements and discounts.

29. To see if the Town, in consideration of One Dollar, annual rental, will vote to lease to the Van Buren Tennis Club for the ensuing year, part of lots two and four and lots twenty-one and twenty-three.

30. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25.00 for advertising our natural resources, advantages and attraction, under the provisions of Chapter Four, Section Fifty-nine of the Revised Statutes of Maine, the same to be expended by the Maine Development Association.

31. To transact all other necessary business that may properly come before said meeting.

The Selectmen will be in session at the Selectmen's Office in said town of Van Buren, on the 29th and 30th days of March, 1926, from 9 A. M. to 5 P. M. for the purpose of correcting the list of voters.
