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To the Superintending School Committee and Citizens of the town of Van Buren:

In accordance with the school laws of Maine, I have the pleasure to herewith submit for your consideration the annual report of the condition and progress of the public schools of the town of Van Buren.

Again the records of our enrollment for the present year show that we have been consistent in holding our ground in spite of the industrial decline of the past few years. Below is a list of schools, the grade, the number of pupils, and the name of the teacher teaching the same.

From an average taken from the terms in the common school registration, we find 1,402 under the instruction of 46 teachers—making an average of 30 pupils per teacher, which compares favorably with the average throughout the State.

In our high schools we have 158 pursuing their secondary work—94 girls and 64 boys. Here again we find an increased attendance over last year, showing that there is a strong tendency on the part of the parents to see that their boys and girls get into high school.

Very little repairs were undertaken this last year. At the Calixte Violette school some much needed repairs were made, including a wood shed.

I trust the time is not far distant when the Marquis, Tardif and C. Violette districts will have new school buildings, replacing the old-fashioned box car schools, poorly ventilated, with windows on all sides as eye destroyers. I believe we should replace one of these time-worn buildings each year by a modern standardized rural school building, embracing the standards of heating, ventilation, lighting and sanitation. And I believe we should have the best teacher possible in the rural schools, because if you have a poor teacher you are bound to have a poor school, no matter what sort of building and equipment you have. A good teacher will always do something worth while. At present we are better supplied with rural teachers than we have ever been.

If the long hoped for industrial boom reaches us by the passage of the Fish River Bill, we must realize that by the increased population of newcomers we would find ourselves severely cramped for school privileges. We should begin immediately to formulate a program that would best meet the interest of all concerned.

During the present winter the attendance in many schools has been seriously reduced by sickness. The situation seems considerably brighter at present, and I urge all parents to closely follow up this attendance program co-operating with the teachers, because under this new distribution of State School Funds every day a pupil is out of school he is a liability to his town.

Again I urge the parents and all others interested in the schools of Van Buren to visit them more often, in this way you will be able to gain an idea of the type of work being carried on and we certainly would profit by any suggestions which you might care to offer.

In comparison to other towns in the State and County we are expending considerably less per capita elementary and secondary education. I believe you will agree that the schools have prospered under the care and instruction of competent teachers who are interested in the welfare of your children; such teachers are worthy of the co-operation of the parents and the appreciation of all citizens who would promote the interests of the community. No town in the State really undertook a more ambitious program in the erection of buildings, more equipment, better trained teachers than Van Buren in the last ten years.

In conclusion I ask the voters of Van Buren to "Hold the Ground Gained" and when these "anticipated" mills begin operations and new neighbors flock among us we will be able to comfortably receive their children in our schools.

In closing this, my annual report, I wish to express my appreciation of the courteous treatment I have received from the Board of Selectmen and from the School Committee and the hearty response of all teachers.

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**WARRANT**

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**For the Annual Town Meeting**

To Vital Cormier, a Constable of the town of Van Buren, in the County of Aroostook and State of Maine.

Greeting:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town of Van Buren, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the "Gayety Theatre" so-called, in said town of Van Buren, on Saturday, the 30th day of March, A. D. 1929, at ten o'clock in the forenoon to act on the following articles, to wit:

ART. 1—To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ART. 2—To choose a Clerk for the ensuing year.

ART. 3—To choose all necessary town officers for the ensuing year.

ART. 4—To see if the town will vote to elect or instruct the Selectmen to appoint a Road Commissioner in accordance with Section 16 of Chapter 92 of the Public Laws of 1919.

ART. 5—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for General Government as follows:—Selectmen, Assessors, Overseers of Poor, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Collector of Taxes and Departmental Expenses.

ART. 6—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Highways, Sidewalks and Bridges as follows:—Maintenance and Equipment, Roads and Bridges, Sidewalks, Road Commissioner, winter roads and patrol maintenance.

ART. 7—To see if the town will vote “Yes” or “No” on the question of appropriating and raising money necessary to entitle the town to State Aid, as Provided in Section 19 of Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes.

ART. 8—To see if the town will appropriate and raise the sum of \$1,194.00 for the improvement of the section of the State Aid road as outlined in the report of the State Highway Commission, in addition to the amounts regularly raised for the care of ways, highways and bridges; the above amount being the maximum which the town is allowed to raise under the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes.

ART. 9—To see if the town will vote to raise money to be expended on the Parent Settlement Road, the Levasseur Road, the Castonguay Road and the Deschaines Road, and if so, what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for said roads.

ART. 10—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the sidewalks in the villages of Van Buren and Keegan.

ART. 11—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise and appropriate to establish signs at intersections of streets or at corners of streets designating the name of said streets.

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ART. 12—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Health and Sanitation as follows, viz:—Board of Health, Health Officer, Tuberculosis and Vital Statistics, also Plumbing Inspector.

ART. 13—To see what sum of money the town will vote to grant and raise for Charities and Corrections for the ensuing year, to wit: Support of Poor, Mothers' Aid and Dependent Children.

ART. 14—To see what sum of money the town will vote to grant and raise for the Protection of Persons and Property as follows, viz:—Police Department, Fire Department, Fire Inspector and Firemen, Hydrant Rental and Street Lights.

ART. 15—To see what sum of money the town will vote to grant and raise for the payment of insurance premiums—workmen's compensation insurance.

ART. 16—To see if the town will vote to install additional street lights and hydrants, and, if so, how many, and also to determine the location of same.

ART. 17—To see what sum of money the town will vote to grant and raise for Education as follows, viz:—Superintendent of Schools, Superintending School Committee, Truant Officers, Common School Teachers' Wages, Common School Tuition and Board, Common School Conveyance, Common School Fuel, Common School Janitors, Common School Supplies, Common School Text Books, High School Teachers' Wages, High School Conveyance, High School Supplies and Text Books, and Interest on School Lots.

ART. 18—To see what sum of money the town will vote to grant and raise for Common School Repairs, Insurance and Water and Lights.

ART. 19—To see if the town will vote to authorize the Superintending School Committee to place one or more rural schools in good condition, and if so, what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise for such purposes.

ART. 20—To see if the town will vote to raise money for the payment of interest on bonds, interest and also for contingent expenses.

ART. 21—To see if the town will vote to grant and raise money to create a sinking fund for the purpose of paying off bond indebtedness.

ART. 22—To see if the town will vote to accept the Municipal Officers' Report.

ART. 23—To see if the town will vote to grant and raise money to take care of abatements and discounts.

ART. 24—To see if the town will vote to fix a time when taxes shall become due and payable; and will vote to make any discount upon taxes paid at such time or times as it may determine; and if so, what per cent, also, to fix a time and rate of interest to be added on taxes remaining unpaid.

ART. 25—To see if the town will vote to lease the Van Buren Tennis Club for the ensuing year part of Lots two and four and Lots twenty-one and twenty-three on the College Tract so-called.

ART. 26—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise and appropriate to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of the State of Maine.

ART. 27—To see if the town will vote to authorize the Superintending School Committee to sell the Levasseur school house so-called under such terms or terms as said Superintending School Committee may determine.

ART. 28—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise to be expended on the Dube and Lake Road so-called and also on the Lake Road so-called.

ART. 29—To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen and Treasurer to execute and negotiate town of Van Buren notes for a sum not greater than \$100,000.00 payable during the year within which same are made out of the money raised during such current year by taxation, and bearing such rate of interest as said Selectmen and Treasurer may determine.

ART. 30—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise for dust preventative for the village streets.

ART. 31—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to raise and appropriate for Memorial Day.

ART. 32—To see if the town will vote to grant and raise money to pay the Van Buren Boys' Band for open air concerts for the ensuing year.



ART. 33—To see what sum of money, if any, the town will vote to grant and raise to pay for the services of a public health nurse.

ART. 34—To transact all other necessary business that may properly come before said meeting.

The Selectmen will be in session at the Selectmen's Office in said town on the 27th, 28th, and 29th days of March, 1929, from ten o'clock in the forenoon until five o'clock in the afternoon for the purpose of correcting the list of voters.
