Court - The Petition of John Troxel Jr. &
humbly shewith that on the twenty
ninth day of December in the year Eight
hundred and four a judgment was
rendered against your petitioner
by John Huston one of the Justices of
Marylands Justices of the Peace
for said County in favor of
a certain Elizabeth Davis for
the sum of one pound fifteen
shillings and six pence current
money debt with interest from the
date of four shillings and ten pence
Costs by which said Judgment
he thinks himself aggrieved &
prays and appeal to your Honors
that your Honors will grant
him such relief in the premise
as to your Honors may seem
meet & he will pray &
pray for Pet.
