Port Royal Harbor S.C.
January 22nd 1813

Sir

When the "Montauk" is ready for sea, and Commander Worden deems it proper to move under his orders - you will please take her in tow and carry her to Ossabaw Sound, Coast of Georgia. - A skillful Pilot will be sent to you. -

The "Canandaigua", Captain J. F. Green, is lying off the bar of Ossibaw. The "Dionaea", "Missahickon" and "Wauwinet", with a mortar schooner are lying inside. -

You will remain in Ossabaw to tow back the "Montauk".
