George the second by the grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King  
Defender of the Faith &c To the Sheriff Marshal of our Province of South  
Carolina Greeting we Command you that of the Goods Chattels Lands &  
Tenements of John North — otherwise called John North of Colleton County in the  
Province of South Carolina planter — you run to demand as well

certain Debt of Two hundred & fifty pounds —  
which William Hopton & Thomas Smith lately in our Court of Common Pleas before our  
Justices at Charles Town against him — did recover also thirty three pounds &  
seven pence half penny — like money which to the  
said William & Thomas — were adjudged for their — damages occasioned by the  
detention of the said Debt whereas the said John — is bound as to  
as it is manifest of record that money have you before our Justices of at  
Charles Town on the first Tuesday in October — next to be rendered to  
the said William & Thomas — for their Debt & damages &c And have you then

thence thus went witness John Living Esq one of our Assistants in the absence  
of our Chief Justice at Charles Town the fifth day of July Anno Domini one Thousand seven  
hundred & forty eight and in the twelfth year of our King's.

Greeting We Command You take Richard Palmer otherwise called Richard Palmer of  
Prince Williams Parish in Granville County in the Province aforesaid Planter and him safely  
keep so that you have his Body before <sup>our</sup> Justices at Charles Town the first Tuesday in October  
next to make Satisfaction to James Lemox & David Deas as well for certain Debt of  
two hundred and twenty eight pounds shillings & six pence good & lawful money of the  
Province aforesaid which the said James & David lately in our Court of Common Pleas before  
our Justices at Charles Town against him did recover and also Twenty Seven pence and two  
shillings and six pence which to the said James and David were adjudged for their damages  
occasioned by the Detention of the said Debt whereof the Richard is convicted as to his  
manifest of Record And have you there this Writ Witness John Lining Esq one of our  
Assistant Justices in the absence of our Chief Justice at Charles Town the fifth day of July  
Anno Domini One Thousand seven hundred and forty eight and in the Twentieth second Year  
of our Reign.
