Scholarly Commons Annual Report 2017 - 2018

INTRODUCTION

Scholarly Commons continues to showcase ERAU research globally. While the number of submissions increased by 11.85% over FY 17, downloads grew by 43.89% in FY 18. In addition, new conferences, such as the 2018 International Civil Aviation English Association (ICAEA) and ERAU's AviAsian Conference, were added. The annual ICAEA Conference is held in a different international location each year and the Daytona Beach Campus served as the host this year. The AviAsian Conference is sponsored on ERAU's Singapore Campus by faculty from that area.

One of the goals for Scholarly Commons in FY 18 was to work with faculty and other groups on the three campuses to develop an Open Educational Resources (OER) repository. This was realized early in 2018 with the development of a new community in Scholarly Commons, where faculty began hosting course texts comprised of open access resources. In addition, librarians from both the Hunt and Hazy Libraries have begun to work with faculty members, assisting them in incorporating free or low cost open resources or already available library materials into course resources with the end goal of helping students save money they would otherwise spend on costly textbooks.

Since the implementation of Scholarly Commons in 2013, one of our steadfast champions has been Dr. Mike Hickey, Chair of the University Research Council. In May 2018, Dr. Hickey returned to the faculty and his own research. On behalf of the Scholarly Commons Oversight Team, we wish to thank him for his support, wish him well, and encourage him to generate many more submissions to Scholarly Commons.

In the last year, 3,473 new works were published in Scholarly Commons bringing the repository total to 16,308 works. Collectively, over the year these works were downloaded 384,842 times with an all-time download count of 1,123,325.

Set up a new community to collect research for the Daytona Beach Cognitive Engineering Research in Transportation Systems (CERTS) Lab.




Created a new community to host Open Educational Resources (OER).




Launched a website for the <u>International Civil Aviation English</u> Association (ICAEA) 2018 Conference.



The first video chronicling a Study Abroad course experience for CSO 399 appears in Scholarly Commons.




The <u>Journal of Aviation/Aerospace Education & Research</u> (JAAER) publishes its first special issue with publications from the NTAS Conference.
