

Refugee-A person who has been forced to leave their country in order to escape war, persecution, or natural disaster.

<u>Genocide</u>-Deliberate killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation.

<u>P.T.S.D.</u>.-A mental health condition triggered by experiencing or seeing a terrifying event.

Anarchy-A state of disorder due to absence or nonrecognition of authority.

Influx of those directly affected


Government faces internal conflict

Economy fluctuates







War can always be stripped down to a difference of opinions




Is War a Problem?
