REPORT:

[To accompany S. 632.]

The Committee on Claims, to whom was referred the bill (S. 632) for the relief of P. B. Sinnott, late Indian agent at Grande Ronde Agency, in the State of Oregon, respectfully recommend its passage.

The committee have heretofore fully considered House bill No. 4155, for the relief of the said Sinnott, which bill is identical in language with the Senate bill, and have reported it to the House (Report No. 1202) with a favorable recommendation.

The substitution of the Senate bill for the House bill is recommended and that the latter lie on the table.
