Mr. Strong, from the Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, made the following

REPORT:

The Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, to whom was referred the petition of Andrew McKim, praying for a pension, respectfully report:

That the alleged services of the petitioner were rendered in the Indian wars, in 1791 and 1792, under General St. Clair. No general provision having been made by law for pensions for such services, your committee are of opinion that it would be inexpedient to make the case of the petitioner an exception; and they, therefore, recommend that the prayer of the petitioner be denied.
