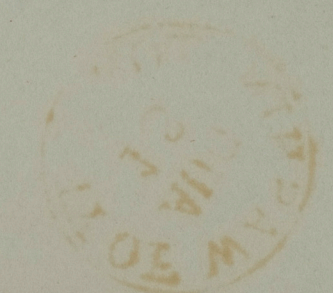
Your of the 6th has been read
