Dorchester house Sept 6th 1813

Sir and Brother

Your favor of the 26th August
I only received yesterday, and sincerely regret
that the Deputy G.P., should ever in any way
to merit the disapprobation of the G.P., I have
written to him this day on the subject, and I
conceive to ~~be~~ Brotherly feeling not to take
any direct step until I hear from him in
reply, but you will be so good as to inform
the Standing Committee that I shall not lose
sight of their communication, and pay every
consideration to the subject, that there has
been much mismanagement in the Masonic
concerns is too evident, many lodges having
been that cause already, and the G.P.
of Dublin, and have no doubt many more
will do the same, now that the Duke of
etc has succeeded Lord Donoughmore
and have the Honor to be Sir Brother
