Washington 24<sup>th</sup> February 1835

House R's -

4 P.M.

Dear Sir

After a scuffle of three or four hours in Com<sup>rs</sup> of the whole, we have succeeded in getting in an appropriation of fifty thousand dollars for ~~an~~ <sup>the</sup> improvement of the navigation above the falls of the Ohio - I spoke twice in favour of the bill, & made the adoption of the amendments to this effect the line qua non, of my voting on all appropriations that might be offered from any other quarter - except in case of a war! - The vote was a large one in our favour - by the way the news is that the American minister has not left Paris - but that the Minister has sent a speech to the Chambers, condemning the speech of the Pres<sup>ts</sup> but saying he is only a single organ of the Govt. & there is no reason to believe



he will be sustained by the other branches -  
but, that nevertheless they recommend to  
the Chambers the passage of the bill - This  
is said to be official - we shall have  
however a report from the Com<sup>r</sup> on  
Foreign Relations tomorrow - & then  
I will be able to give you the whole  
truth -
