Washington, Bk. of Metropolis, July 21. 1834

Moses Dawson Esq.

D. Sir

Your's dated the 13th Inst. did not reach
me until (yesterday) too late to prevent a
protest of W. T. Dawson's. To note I have
this morning (Monday) handed in the new
note — I return the check enclosed — it appearing
that there are only $\$2\frac{59}{100}$ to the credit of W. T. Dawson.
You will please forward the discount ^{or} required —
say $31\frac{33}{100}$. — The former note will be cancelled
in Bank —

I think it is evident now that the Bk
of U. S. is striking it's flag —
