My dear Senator Capper:

As chairman of the Brandenburg Silver Jubilee Committee, I am writing you asking you to be our speaker at the exercises on Friday morning, March 18, at 10 o'clock. I think Miss Lula McPherson, who is chairman of the program committee, and Mr. F. W. Brinkerhoff have written you. The anniversary committee was unanimous in its desire to have you our speaker for the occasion.

You will receive later on a complete program of the week's activities. Friday is to be a day set aside especially for the men who have been associated with President Brandenburg in building the institution. We are making an effort to have the governors, boards of regents, senators, and representatives of the State who have worked with President Brandenburg during his twenty-five years here, and a large group of representative school men present on this day.

There is no one for whom we have a more friendly feeling than yourself, and no one whom we would rather have with us at that time. I sincerely hope that in your busy life with the many demands upon you you can in some way arrange to be with us.
