Mr. Eva Terry,

On Monday I had Mr. Starr and the Recreation Director, Mr. Schaefer, to lunch.

The fees I named were \$ 11.00 for three, viz:-
the dance teacher \$ 5.00, the dancing partner \$ 3.00,
the musician \$ 3.00. This is acceptable to Mr. Starr;
classes limited to twenty. (This to be somewhat flexible.)

Curiously what they fear is the difficulty of getting the Union members to desire to join in the folk-dancing; so they will start with two or three groups.

I suggested that Mr. Moore should be the one through whom Mr. Starr deals with the dance teachers as a group.

Mr. von der Goltz and I will keep up the effort to produce results.
