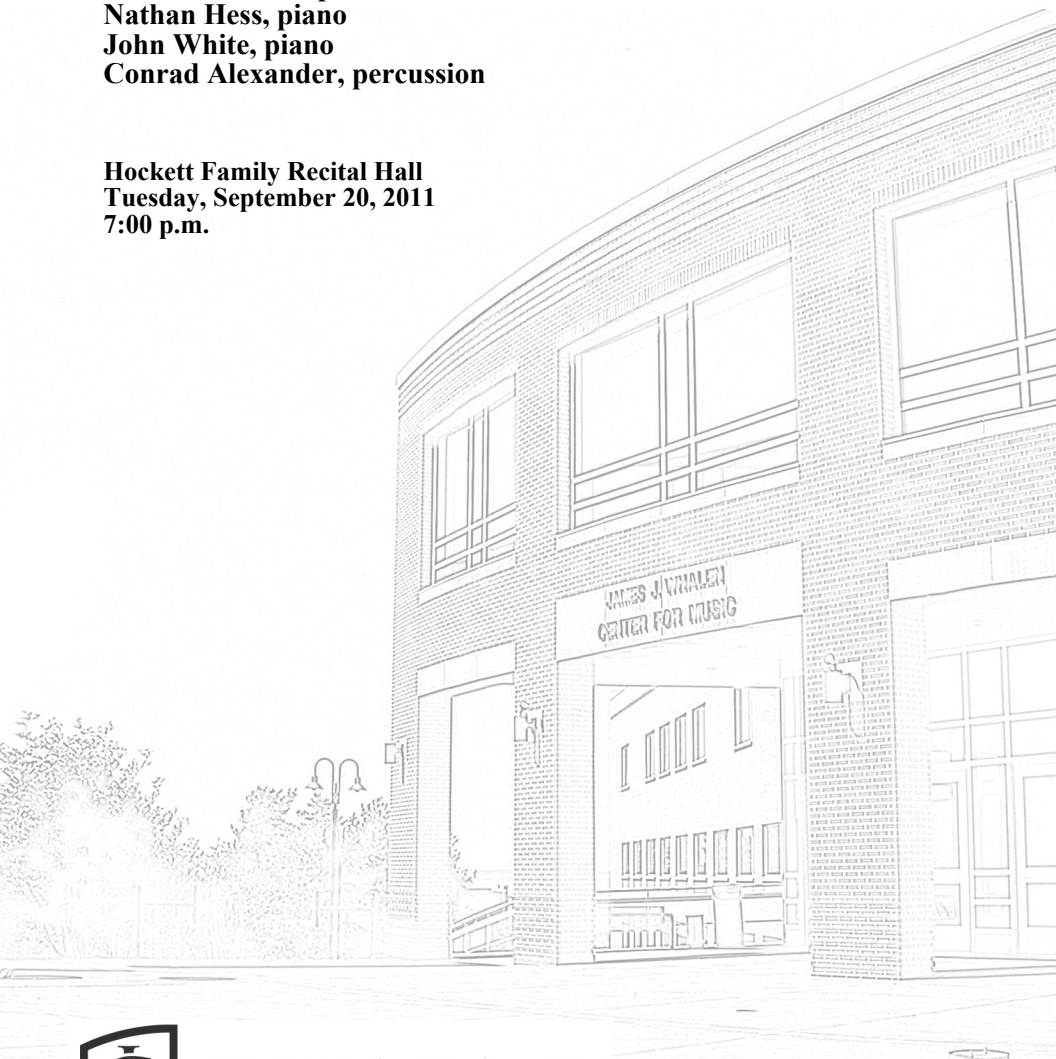

## Notes

### **As In a Dream** **two songs for soprano, violin, and cello** **Chen Yi (1988)**

The words of the songs come from two poems by a famous poetess Li Qing-zhao of the Song Dynasty (960-1279). The reciting speech and lingering charm of the Chinese traditional opera are absorbed as nourishment so as to transmit the sentimental feelings of remembering the happy past times and treasuring flowers and spring scenery, leaving a lasting impression after the ending of the pieces. The music is dedicated to soprano Ms. Rao Lan who invited and inspired the composer to create this work.
