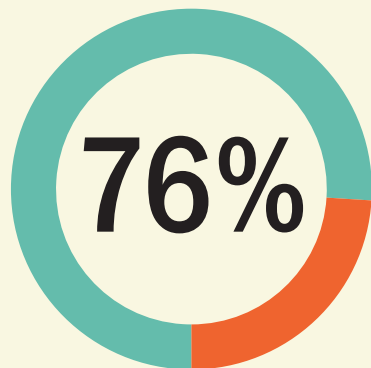


WHAT IS ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE?

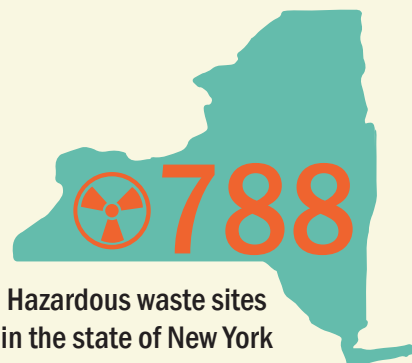
76% of residents living within 3 miles of any of the 12 most noxious power plants are people of color.
