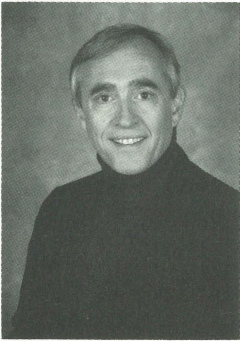

Robert A. Kvam is in his eleventh year as Director of the School of Music at Illinois Wesleyan University, Bloomington, Illinois, where he administers a program with nearly 200 students in professional and liberal arts programs. Dr. Kvam has been a member of the faculty at Mount Holyoke College in South Hadley, Massachusetts, and at the Army/Navy Band School in Norfolk, Virginia.

Professor Kvam is an active choral conductor/adjudicator who directs the University Choir, and has been the conductor of the Illinois Symphony Chorus and the Kankakee Symphonic Choir. He is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association and the National Association of Teachers of Singing. He studied choral conducting with Robert Fountain, Elmer Thomas, John Leman and Earl Rivers, and voice with David Astor, Charles Matheson, Jon Spong and Andrew White. Dr. Kvam is also a member of Pi Kappa Lambda, faculty advisor to the Alpha Lambda Chapter of Phi Mu Alpha, an Honorary Fellow for Sigma Alpha Iota, and an active participant in the Illinois Music Educators Association.

Professor Kvam has served as a member of the Evaluation Team for NASM for the past eight years and continues in this position.

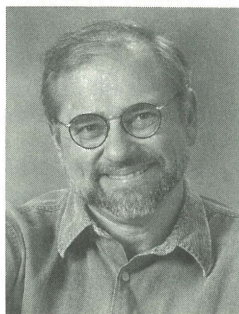


Rodney Winther is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the Ithaca College School of Music. Conductor of the Ithaca College Wind Ensemble since 1982, Mr. Winther also teaches graduate and undergraduate conducting, wind literature, and directs the Masters program in wind conducting. He is known for his championing of contemporary music.

Mr. Winther has conducted the premiere performances of works by such distinguished composers as Warren Benson, David Amram, Roger Nixon, Raymond Premru, Gordon Stout, Dana Wilson, and numerous others. Mr. Winther's frequent appearances as guest conductor and clinician have taken him across the United States and abroad, including the Republic of Malaysia as a cultural specialist sponsored by the United States Information Agency. Since 1993 he has been invited to England on eight separate occasions including the past four years for his Conducting Workshops which have been held in both London and at the University of Kent at Canterbury. This

July also marked Mr. Winther's fourth summer as guest conductor of the Kent Youth Wind Orchestra at their summer course in Benenden, Kent, with additional concerts at Fairfield Hall in Croydon, the University of Huddersfield for the annual BASBWE Conference, and the summer Music Festival at Deal. This year in the United States will see him conduct various festival bands in Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and New York, in addition to All-State groups in Connecticut and Rhode Island. This past January brought his first engagement with the United States Navy Band as he was invited to guest conduct this auspicious ensemble at the 19th International Saxophone Symposium. His recordings with the Ithaca College Wind Ensemble (Mark Records) have brought them national and international recognition, having been played on National Public Radio stations in the United States, as well as the B.B.C. in England and other national stations throughout Europe. Most recently, Mr. Winther has been asked by the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music to conduct the CCM Wind Symphony in a pair of concerts during a nine week period as a Visiting Professor of Music.

Mr. Winther holds degrees from the University of Idaho (M.M. and B. Mus. Ed.) and was in residence at the Eastman School of Music for two years while working toward the D.M.A. in conducting. In addition to extensive public school teaching, he has also taught at Walla Walla College, Purdue University and Oregon State University. While at the Eastman School he served as assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Wind Orchestra, studied privately with Donald Hunsberger and David Effron, and taught undergraduate conducting.



David Harman continues to be in great demand both as a guest conductor of professional orchestras and as a music educator at the university and high school levels. Recent professional appearances include return engagements with The Louisville Orchestra, The Cincinnati Symphony, The Tucson Symphony, The Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, and The Lake Placid Sinfonietta.

He has also appeared with the Opera Theater of Rochester and with the Orchestra of the Spring Festival of Contemporary Music in Ljubljana, Slovenia under the sponsorship of Arts America. During 1994, Harman also served as guest conductor of the The Shanghai Conservatory Symphony (China) and the Jamaica Orchestra for Youth (JOY) in Kingston, Jamaica. Future plans include return

visits to China and Jamaica as well as an invitation from the National Orchestra of Chile in Santiago.

Dr. Harman currently holds the posts of Professor of Music and Director of Orchestral Activities at the University of Rochester River Campus, Conductor and Music Director of the Rochester Philharmonic Youth Orchestra and Music Director for Educational Services for the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra. He came to Rochester from Louisville, Kentucky where he conducted the University of Louisville Orchestra, Civic Orchestra, and Opera Theater Productions for eight years and served as executive secretary of the Grawemeyer Award for Music Composition. He has also held similar tenured positions at the University of Connecticut and Colorado State University.

In addition to bachelors and masters degree from California State University at Sacramento, he was a scholarship student at the Paris Conservatory (France) and the Aspen Music Festival, and earned a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the Eastman School of the University of Rochester in 1974 at age 25. Dr. Harman has also enjoyed an active solo career as a clarinetist with three solo recordings (most recently with pianist Anton Nel in a composition by Rochester's David Liptak), recital appearances at Carnegie Recital Hall, London's Wigmore Hall and Purcell Room as well as recorded broadcasts for the B.B.C., O.R.T.F., WGBH, WQXR, and National Public Radio. He is married to Nan Harman and has two step-daughters, Heidi and Heather as well as a cat, Odo.
