1828

My Dear Sister Finley.

As one of our Neighbors  
is coming to Sandusky, I take the liberty to send  
you by him some a few lines. He comes a stranger to  
that part of the Country, having travel Mr Price  
speak of Brother Finley. He desired him to write  
a few line by way of introduction, but owing  
to a multiplicity of business, Mr Price has not been  
able to do it, the task therefore devolves on me.  
Mr Fox, is a sober, industrious moral young man  
Mr Price has known him from a little Boy. He  
was brought up in the very respectable Methodist  
family in Gerry — He comes into your Neighbors  
Grovell for the purpose of purchasing Land if  
he can be suited and if Brother Finley can  
render him any assistance, he will be much  
obliged, and we shall feel gratified —  
I shall be pleased to have a letter from you  
by the return of Mr Fox, and hope that you  
enjoy your health and abundant support and  
consolation in the arduous work you are engage  
in. I have been quite sick but through many  
and restored to my usual health again. Mr  
Price is well, he is to day at Lebanon, we  
are both still striving to walk the narrow  
path, we meet with some difficulties and  
trials, but trust that none of them shall

which is in Christ Jesus. We had a good Quarterly  
Meeting at Lebanon on this day week. Brother  
Broader preach'd a sermon on which my soul  
feasted. Brother Wright also preach'd an

have not gone to Washington but expect to  
start out shortly. Brother Brewster formerly  
wrote well the last I heard from him.
