Warren County Ohio May 18<sup>th</sup> 1828

My Dear Sister Finley.

As one of our Neighbours is coming to Sandusky, I take the liberty to send you by him a few lines. He comes a stranger to that part of the Country, having heard Mr Price speak of Brother Finley, he desired him to write a few lines by way of introduction, but owing to a multiplicity of Business, Mr Price has not been able to do it, the task therefore devolves on me. Mr Fox, is a sober, industrious moral young Man Mr Price has known him from a little Boy, he was brought up in the very respectable Methodist household for the purpose of purchasing Land if he can be suited and if Brother Finley can render him any assistance, he will be much obliged, and we shall feel gratified. I shall be pleased to hear a letter from you by the return of Mr Fox, and hope that you enjoy your health and abundant support and consolation in the arduous work you are engaged in. I have been quite sick but through mercy am restored to my usual health again. Mr Price is well, he is to day at Lebanon, we are both still striving to walk the narrow path, we must see the some difficulties and trials, but trust that none of them shall
