Cincinnati Decem: 13th 1832

Reverend Dear Sir { From the tenor of your last
Letter we have been expecting you here for some days, and
we have been very anxious on the subject in consequence of
a glorious work that the Lord is carrying on amongst
us - Brother Maffitt has now been here 2 weeks and we
have preaching or a prayer meeting every night and most
gracious blessings attend every meeting, the altar is crowded
with mourners every night and about 100 has joined
Society: notwithstanding all this there seems an apathy,
a coldness in the Church that I cannot account for
and I think if you could make our City a visit just
now, your presence would give life and energy and
that we might hope for as glorious a revival as our
western country has never yet experienced - do come
down at once if you possibly can - I would
write much more but the mail is just closing -

We are all well and join in love to you and
yours - My own health is better than it has been
for years - we shall be much disappointed
if you cannot come
