Cincinnati Jan 5th 1846

Rev S. B. Finney

Dr Sir. I have a letter from
you directed to my Brother and received by
him last evening. from which I learn
that you intend going out to Hancock Co
to set your lands. You want to know if I
have paid the Tax on the land you bought
of me. I answer No. I have written out to
Mr Elijah Williams Esq. My Agent in
Finley to ascertain the amount of
my Taxes. and he by mistake
left me the amount for last year
and I had to write back for the
amount for 1845. and send out the
receipt for 1844 which I had in
my possession. As soon as I can
find out the true amount I will
immediately send over the money
or if you see fit to pay it when you
are out. I will repeat it to you as soon
as I see you. From
