I was favoured with from you said that it was your intention to visit Lancaster soon it is now two months since which encourage me to claim the fulfilment of your promise which I do not only on my own & families a/c but in behalf of our congregation I am of the opinion that a good work is progressing in our midst and that you may be the means of winning many souls to Jesus Mother Moody dear man is nearly worn out and unite with me in desiring you to come over on Monday next we are to have a Society meeting that night consequently will not ask you under your fatigue of traveling to labour until Tuesday - I believe that you was the Pioneer that first organized this ^{church} ~~meeting~~ and that you will ^{make} some sacrifice for our spiritual good
