Forest Cottage Highland Co. Ohio Aug. 31/52  
 Mr James P. Finley  
 Dear Uncle we received with pleasure  
 your affectionate epistle a few days since  
 we looked for you to visit our cottage for  
 some time until <sup>we</sup> heard that you were on a  
 trip to Wisconsin, the correctness of which  
 report we were unable to learn from  
 your letter but suppose it was not true  
 and you would have said something of it.

It would be gratifying for us to visit  
 you before conference, but we will now  
 be compelled to forego this purpose. Some  
 two weeks since I sold my farm  
 and am now disposing of my stock  
 grain, grass &c. I sold my farm for  
 twelve hundred dollars more than I gave for  
 it. If we find it in the course of probability  
 we intend visiting you after conference.  
 It may be that we may be nearer you  
 than we now are. Indeed situated  
 as we are on it would be almost  
 impossible to <sup>keep</sup> Mrs. Finley
