Cincinnati, Jan. 19, 1826. —

Dear Brother, I hereby send you a draft of \$50 according to your request. It is payable to your order & will require your name on the back of it. The balance is placed to your credit. I could not obtain a draft for you on New York, but this will answer about as well.

I received a number of the Magazine for you, & have paid the postage & shall send it with this letter. The Agents at New York ought to have directed it to Sandusky. — I have received the Minutes from New York, after waiting for them 5 or 6 weeks. I have not a copy to send you until I get them printed, which will be in about 2 weeks. In the meantime I will give you the <sup>held</sup> time of some of the Conferences. The Virginia Conference is to be at Portsmouth, Virginia, the 15th of February. — Baltimore Conference at Baltimore the 15th of March. — Philadelphia Conference at Philadelphia, the 14th of April. — Francis Hicks is well. — yours in love — In haste —
