Dear Sir,

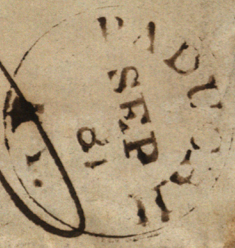
Yours of the 29<sup>th</sup> ultimo is
