Thomas Bruton, that Matters in his behalf are progressing favorably. The business of his Brother with the Government - takes time as each one must have his turn according to the time of his application, both for the Pay and the Land warrant.

As to his Pardon, I feel confident about that, as I have wrote to and Rec'd upon some of the Most influential Men in Ohio - Letters that will tell with Gov^r Bebb. It is my intention when I have Rec'd what I believe to be sufficient, and when I have Rec'd from the Mayor of Cincinnati and from the Rev. Alpheus Moody their Report in the Matter, to see the Gov^r supersor, and also to his At-leolumbus. Nothing that can be done in my power will be left undone. Will you please drop a line to Yours in the Best of Bonds Rev. Moody and the Mayor of Cincinnati urging them as to now some time since I wrote } Joshua Robinson
