Father Finley

I take this opportunity of asking your kind aid again in behalf of Brother James he wrote to me the gov would not offer pardon unless the Prosecutor would sign a Petition I found after trying there was some hope of obtaining their consent by obtaining a letter from you of James conduct and if there was a recommendation in his Character also one from the attending Physician that confinement was injurious and dangerous to his Health I did feel like gov Bell would Pardon after the signature of those persons with whom he would be an inhabitant amongst I yet have the hope that he will through your kind influence extend to him his Pardoning Prerogative I cannot help Father Finley but think that after the death of our Father and his last counsels with surrounding circumstances that James would prove a worthy citizen for in this I am called upon to think of that passage Thou shalt forgive sea seventy and seven and if you will be so kind as to send me by mail I will try the same before the gov ten is out you in haste
