Thomas Circuit 27 Jan. 1826.

Dear Brother.

Altho we are strangers
in the flesh, yet we have some
knowledge of each other as Methodist
Ministers engaged in the same
good work of doing good in the
Church & in the world.—

As we have a Camp meeting
appointed to be held on the 1st
May next commencing on the 19.
The New settlement 25 Miles
below Motley where there is a
good harbour for Boats. I wish
you to attend and bring with
those Teachers and friends you
think proper with you. I hope
you will come we will want
help and your aid will be thank-
fully received.

Our Mission and school
on the Grand River is prospering.
