This finds us in good health but
how long is not known to us
for we do not know what tomorrow
may bring forth but I think that
we will try to live so that we
may not be ashamed to do at
this time I have plenty of work
to do in fact I have as much as me
and two hands can do I am doing
well hear better then I could any
where I could go when you went
up to Columbus I learn from Anna
that you would like to see me I
am sorry that I was not in at the time
I learn that you wanted me to look out
a small property and see what I could
get for and on what condition there
is plenty of property here for different
prices there is one property which can
be bought for one hundred & forty dollars
and hundred & twenty the first of April
and the balance in ten years but
there is property here that is cheaper
in the long run taken every thing
in to consideration but I will write
till you come home and you can fully
judge for your self. Heavy as all well
at home no man of pleasure but
