Dear Grandfather
 this finds us in good health but
 how long it will remain to us
 for we do not know what tomorrow
 may bring forth but I think that
 we will try to live so that we
 may not be ashamed to die at
 this time I have plenty of work
 to do in fact I have as much as me
 and too hands can do I am doing
 well here better than I could any
 where I could go when you went
 up to Columbus I learn from Ann
 that you would like to see me I
 am sorry that I was not in at the time
 I learn that you wanted me to look out
 a small property and see what I could
 get for and on what condition there
 is plenty of property here for different
 prices there is one property which can
 be had for one hundred to forty dollars
 one hundred down the first of April
 and the balance in ten years but
 there is property here that is cheaper
 in the long run taken every thing
 in to consideration but I will wait
 till you come here and you can
 judge for your self. Stay as well
 at home no money at present but
 remain your in love
